SCHOOL SCRIP PROGRAM

Based on feedback we have received from various parents, there will be a “**BUY OUT**” option of the SCRIP requirement for 2010-2011 school year.

The SCRIP year starts on June 1, 2010 and ends on May 31, 2011.

The “**BUY OUT**” option is \$200 paid in a separate check to the SCRIP program. In September, Fr Tony, Ms Everett and the Consultative Board will meet to discuss the distribution of these funds and what school programs they will support. This year’s pilot program provided some student assistance.
